THE PENTA BUILDING GROUP RAISES \$120,000 FOR NEVADA NONPROFITS DURING 12TH ANNUAL CHARITY GOLF CLASSIC

LAS VEGAS (June 2, 2016) – The PENTA Building Group (PENTA), a leading commercial contractor headquartered in Nevada, announced today the company raised \$120,000 for three Nevada nonprofits during its recent 12th Annual Charity Golf Classic at the Revere Golf Club. The event generated widespread community support and welcomed 312 golfers, more than 80 volunteers and sponsorship and support from more than 100 companies.

As a result of the event, PENTA donated \$40,000 to each of the three recipient nonprofits: the Nevada Childhood Cancer Foundation (NCCF), the Women's Development Center (WDC) and the Nevada Military Support Alliance (NMSA). "This year's tournament was better than ever and we owe that to the many Subcontractors, Vendors, Clients and Employees who donated their time and resources to support three great causes," said John Cannito, PENTA's Chief Operating Officer. "As a community-focused organization, PENTA strives to support local nonprofits that provide valuable services to those in need. We respect the tireless efforts of these recipient nonprofits and we are proud to help fund their services for women, children and veterans across Southern Nevada."

The NCCF will apply the funds toward its largest adolescent program, Project Aids and Resources for Kids (ARK), which provides support for more than 800 local families with children who have cancer and other life-threatening illnesses, said Jeff Gordon, the nonprofit's president and CEO.

"We are so grateful for the incredible efforts that the PENTA Building Group puts into this community each and every year. Their golf tournament allows the charities to fund so much of what we do," Gordon said. "From each of our families and the many children that depend on us and this community, we thank PENTA and all the sponsors and golfers for being such an important part of our family. I hope you all realize the magnitude of the impact you have."

The WDC will use the funds to provide housing for community members in need, said nonprofit Executive Director Tina Prieto. "Stable housing leads to a family being able to focus on other issues, as they are not worrying about having a roof over their head. This leads to getting better jobs, improving their financial situation, pursuing education or getting their GED," Prieto said. "Because of The PENTA Building Group's continued support, homeless families, homeless veterans, seniors, people with disabilities and survivors of domestic violence are able to lead a life they never knew was possible."

The NMSA works to organize and promote the recognition, support and appreciation of Nevada's men and women in the armed forces, veterans and their families.

"We truly appreciate the generosity of The PENTA Building Group employees, suppliers and partners," said NMSA Executive Director Teresa Di Loreto. "Without their support we would not accomplish our mission to appreciate, recognize and support the men and women of Nevada who have served or currently serve our great nation."

Supporting local nonprofits remains a top priority for PENTA.
